(Does NOT include hotel or airline costs)

GROUND PACKAGE W/O HOTEL: Attendees can register here for the ground package for the Abby House Dedication activities. The \$300 fee is per person and includes everything in the posted schedule.

The package is designed to give each attendee an opportunity to experience the lovely southern area of Belize's Toledo District where Abby Brinkman worked at Hillside Healthcare to serve the medical needs of the local people. Participants will have the opportunity to see local villages, visit a Mayan ruin, take a ride up a jungle river, enjoy a number of educational dinners...and of course, join Roger and Jan Brinkman as the Abby House dormitory is dedicated to the memory of their daughter, Abigail Brinkman.

This remarkable region borders on the Caribbean and consists of jungles and rainforests with little villages scattered around the remote landscape. You will enjoy the diversity of local cultures—Mayan, Garifuna, Hispanic, Creole, and East Indian.

There are two short morning work projects on the schedule (not too difficult!) that will allow guests to assist with Hillside's work while getting to know a couple of our Hillside families who are in great need.

Reservations for the ground package are limited, so reserve your spot soon.

YOUR HOTEL RESERVATION: Hotels reservations can be made online. Be sure to tell them you are with Hillside's Abby House group. See hotel prices at end of the schedule! Each suggested hotel has a website you can peruse.

YOUR AIRLINE FLIGHT: Each person is responsible for their own airline reservations. Note that flights must arrive in Belize City International airport (don't be confused with Belize City Municipal airport!) in time to catch your connecting flight to Punta Gorda (your final destination) on Tropic Air or Maya Air the same afternoon—in order to avoid an overnight stay in Belize City.
